WHAT TO DO IF YOU HIT AN ANIMAL

Stop:

- Pull off to the side of the road and put on your flashers.
- Use flares or reflective triangles if you have them to warn other drivers.
- Don't approach a wounded animal; it may kick, bite or gore you.
